

**EFFECTIVE – JANUARY 1, 2011**

**THERE WILL BE A 2 % INCREASE IN RATES  
FOR WATER SERVICE IN 2011**

The average residential single family property in Atlantic City currently pays approximately \$207 per year for water. The MUA is currently projecting that, with this rate increase, the average consumer will pay \$212.20 per year. This is a \$5.20 per year increase.

**THE CONNECTION FEE RATE WILL INCREASE**

State Law sets a formula mandating the specific calculation of Connection Fees. State Law further requires that Connection Fees be recalculated at the end of every calendar year, and that all Debt Service and Capital Expenditures be included in the new calculation.

The net result is a proposed Connection Fee in 2011 of \$10.9377 per gallon of average daily flow. This applies to new construction.
