The Board resolved to engage Alaimo 17 18 Engineering, who will bring on as needed Bowman 19 Auditing at a not to exceed \$5,000 range, to put 20 together a response, a critical response to the Ernst 21 and Young study that was promulgated by the City with 22 respect to the Authority. That project is to be 23 turned around in short order and the Board will 24 review the progress of that report at its Board 25 meeting of August on the 19th.

2	Director to be available for a press release and
3	conference room to the Alaimo contract to begin the
4	response to the Ernst and Young report, and also
5	perhaps discussion of the Duck Island proposal that
6	was also presented to both the City and Atlantic City
7	Council.

9	the Board will meet again on its full Board meeting
10	on the 19th of this month.
