**THERE WILL BE AN INCREASE IN RATES
FOR WATER SERVICE IN 2021**

The 2021 rate increase was structured to ensure that the projected revenues would be sufficient to cover the year's anticipated appropriations. The Authority has increased 2% in its flat rate for all customers. The excess rate will remain the same at \$3.762 per 100 cubic feet. The residential flat rate will increase to \$62.25 a quarter from \$61.00 a quarter. The residential rate increase will be applicable on a per unit basis.

THE CONNECTION FEE RATE WILL NOT INCREASE

State Law sets a formula mandating the specific calculation of Connection Fees. State Law further requires that Connection Fees be recalculated at the end of every calendar year, and that all Debt Service and Capital Expenditures be included in the new calculation.

The net result is a proposed Connection Fee in 2021 of \$20.6188 per gallon of average daily flow. This applies to new construction. Any revenue generated from the connection fee will be utilized for capital projects.
